## Search Warrant Conducted at Norwalk, OH Doctor's Office

Norwalk, Ohio (Huron County) - On February 3, 2015, Ohio State Board of Pharmacy Executive Director, Steven Schierholt, Esq., announced that State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies served a search warrant at the office Dr. Robert S. Reeves Jr., M.D., located at 35 Water Street, Norwalk, OH 44857.

The Ohio State Board of Pharmacy conducted a joint investigation in January 2015, with the State Medical Board of Ohio and Norwalk Police Department, in regard to Dr. Reeves' questionable prescribing. The alleged activity included the issuance of prescriptions for controlled and non-controlled substances while Dr. Reeves was absent from the office due to an illness.

Ohio Administrative Code; Manner of Issuance of a Prescription, stipulates in order for a prescription to be valid, it must be dated as of and on the day when issued, which the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy verified was not the case with Dr. Reeves' prescriptions.

The office searched is located at 35 Water Street, Norwalk, OH. Evidence seized included patient charts, fincancial records and prescription drugs.

No arrests were made during the search warrant. This case will be presented to the Huron County Prosecutor's Office for the requested charges of Illegal Processing of Drug Documents and Trafficking in Drugs.
