Introduction

THE MATTER OF ERROL DURONSLET CAME TO HEARING ON JANUARY 29, 1992 BEFORE THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: BETTY J. NICHOL, R.Ph. (presiding); METTA LOU HENDERSON, R.Ph.; PAUL F. LAMPING, R.Ph.; NORMAN D. LEIBOW, R.Ph.; TIMOTHY D. MOORE, R.Ph.; RUTH A. PLANT, R.Ph.; JOSEPH R. SABINO, R.Ph.; AND ROBERT W. VALENTINE, R.Ph.

Finding Of Fact

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Errol Duronslet has complied with the requirements of the Board's Order, Docket No. D-910130-054, dated June 28, 1991.

Action Of The Board

Following this appearance of Errol Duronslet, permitted by the Board's Order, Docket No. D-910130-054, and testimony received from witnesses, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby suspends the six-month suspension imposed in Board Order, Docket No. D-910130-054, and places the pharmacist identification card, No. 03-3-09692, held by Errol Duronslet on probation for a period of five years on the condition that:

- (1) Errol Duronslet must continue his counseling on a monthly basis for the duration of this probation.
- (2) Errol Duronslet will have no unsupervised contact with children.
- (3) Errol Duronslet must submit status reports to the Board every six months including written documentation of monthly counseling and progress reports.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY (Aye-7/Nay-0).

ERROL DURONSLET WAS NOT REPRESENTED BY COUNSEL, AND THE STATE OF OHIO WAS REPRESENTED BY STEVE DLOTT, ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that records of the Board of Pharmacy indicate that Errol Duronslet was originally licensed in the state of Ohio on November 25, 1970, pursuant to reciprocity from the state of Louisiana, and currently practices pharmacy in Ohio.
- (2) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Errol Duronslet did, on or about the month of January, 1988, and during time periods immediately preceding, photograph minors who were not his children or wards and who were in a state of nudity, and he possessed the resulting photographs. Such conduct is in violation of Sections 2907.323(A)(1) and 2907.323(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code, a felony of the second degree and a misdemeanor of the first degree.
- (3) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Errol Duronslet was, on or about August 3, 1988, convicted in the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court of Illegal Use of a Minor in Nudity-oriented Material or Performance in violation of

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Section 2907.323(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, a felony of the second degree. Errol Duronslet was sentenced to serve a period of 2 to 15 years in the Ohio Penitentiary and was released on parole after serving 10 months of that sentence.

- (4) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Errol Duronslet was, on or about September 26, 1988, convicted in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio of Sexual Exploitation of Minors in violation of 18 U.S.C. Section 2252(a)(2). Errol Duronslet was sentenced to serve a period of 10 months to be served concurrently to the state sentence in the Ohio Penitentiary.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (2) through (4) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes being guilty of a felony or gross immorality as provided in Division (A)(1) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

ORDER

Pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy takes the following actions concerning the pharmacist license, No. 03-3-09692, held by Errol Duronslet:

(A) On the basis of the Conclusion Of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby suspends the pharmacist identification card effective November 1, 1991 to May 25, 1992.

(B) Further, Errol Duronslet may appear before the Board prior to November 1, 1991 to petition for reinstatement of his license to practice and, if granted, under what conditions the license will be reinstated provided Mr. Duronslet can present results of an evaluation by the Center for Human Sexuality at the University Hospitals of Cleveland and provide evidence of compliance with the Center's recommendation for treatment.

Division (B) of Section 4729.16 of the Revised Code provides in pertinent part that: "Any individual whose identification card is ..., suspended, ..., shall return his identification card and certificate of registration to the offices of the state board of pharmacy within ten days after receipt of notice of such action." The certificate and identification card should be forwarded by certified mail, return receipt requested.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

Section 119.12 of the Revised Code authorizes an appeal from this Order. Such an appeal may be taken to the court of common pleas in the county in which your place of business is located or to said court of the county in which you reside. If you do not have a place of business in Ohio and are not a resident of Ohio, you may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio.


