

Occasional Wholesale Sales of Naloxone

<u>Section 4729.51 of the Ohio Revised Code</u> permits a licensed terminal distributor of dangerous drugs that is not a pharmacy may make occasional sales of naloxone at wholesale. Please be advised that occasional wholesale sales may include sales to other entities at no-cost.

The purchaser may be any of the following: terminal distributor of dangerous drugs, prescriber as defined in section 4729.01 of the Revised Code, or any entity exempted from licensure as a terminal distributor of dangerous drugs (to include law enforcement agencies) pursuant to section 4729.541 of the Revised Code.

The limits set forth in <u>rule 4729:5-3-09 of the Administrative Code</u> do not apply to licensed terminal distributors that conduct occasional sales of naloxone at wholesale.

Licensed terminal distributors shall comply with all other requirements when conducting occasional wholesale sales of naloxone, including recordkeeping.
