



Ohio Pharmacy Law Course Instructions

Updated 5/28/2026

The Ohio Board of Pharmacy now offers a convenient online law course for pharmacists applying for licensure by taking the UMPJE or via reciprocity. This document explains how to access the Ohio Pharmacy Law Course as well as some important resources to help you succeed. **IMPORTANT – applicants for pharmacist licensure by examination who successfully complete the Ohio MPJE prior to October 1, 2026 are not required to complete this course.**

The Board's Ohio Pharmacy Law Course is designed to provide applicants with critical knowledge on the laws and rules governing the practice of pharmacy. The course was created to be taken in one sitting and is approximately 60-75 minutes in length. It includes 16 law and rule review videos with 6 quiz questions generated between the videos. To pass the Ohio Pharmacy Law Course, you must obtain a score of 75%.

For Reciprocity applicants: Access to the course will be granted when all application requirements are received and reviewed by the Board. Specific application requirements include but are not limited to the following: eLTP application submitted to NABP, BCI, and FBI criminal records checks results, and pharmacist application submitted to the Board via [eLicense Ohio](#).

You **ONLY** have three attempts to pass this quiz. Failure to pass the course within three attempts will result in your application being abandoned and application fee forfeited. In addition, you only have six months to complete the course before your application is deemed abandoned and application fee forfeited.

For examination applicants: Access to the course will be granted when the Board receives the prospective graduate roster from your school of pharmacy. You may complete the course

prior to graduation or after graduation in order to satisfy your Ohio pharmacist licensure requirements. Additionally, you may complete the course prior to taking any examinations.

You will be limited to three attempts to pass this quiz prior to graduating. After graduation, failure to pass the course within three attempts will result in your application being abandoned and application fee forfeited. Your Ohio pharmacist license will not be issued until both examinations (NAPLEX and UMPJE) and this course are completed successfully.

How to Take the Ohio Pharmacy Law Course Online

NOTE: To access the Ohio Pharmacy Law Course, the Board’s Licensing Department will send an email with instructions once the pharmacist applicant has submitted their online application and all of the required application materials or the school of pharmacy has provided the prospective graduate roster.

1. The course will require you to log in with your existing Pharmacy Intern License or Pharmacist Application Number and Security Code. You will receive your Security Code via email from the Board of Pharmacy. After entering your License/Application Number and Security Code, click “Login.”

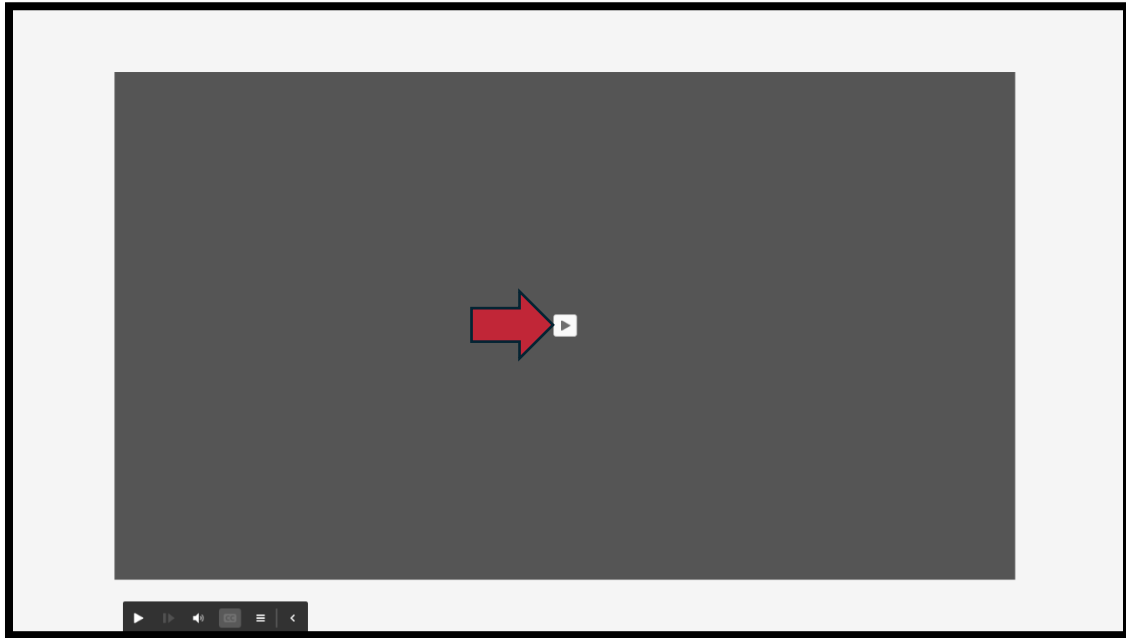

2. Once you log in, you can press the Play button to begin playing the videos in order. Each video generally ranges between 2 and 4 minutes. Course questions will pop up between the videos for you to answer.







GETTING YOUR LICENSE: The Board will also send you an automated email letting you know that you have successfully passed the course. For reciprocity candidates, it will take around 5-7 business days after successfully completing the course for the Board's Licensing Department to issue your license. For examination candidates, the results will be noted on the pharmacist application and your license will be issued after the successful completion of the examinations (NAPLEX and UMPJE).
