### NE Inspector - Cuyahoga County

Inspectors play a critical role in fulfilling the mission of the Board of Pharmacy by being actively involved in the progressive changes within the pharmacy profession. Inspectors have the ability to ensure processes are in place to protect the public.

This Inspector position is assigned to the northeast region of Ohio and includes the following counties: Ashtabula, Lake, Geauga, Trumbull, Mahoning, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Portage, Stark, Carroll, Lorain, Medina, Summit, Wayne, Holmes, & Tuscarawas. The headquarter county assigned to this position is Cuyahoga. The final candidate selected for this position is required to live in or relocate to Cuyahoga county within 180 days of effective date of hire or transfer. **Relocation is non-negotiable.**

#### Inspector Job Duties

- Conducts regulatory inspections of licensed facilities where dangerous drugs are stored, sold, dispensed, compounded, manufactured, or otherwise distributed (e.g., retail pharmacies, emergency medical services, jail facilities, first aid rooms, health clinics, & veterinary clinics) to ensure compliance with all Ohio & federal drug laws & regulations relating to the legal distribution of dangerous drugs (i.e., reviews security & accountability pertaining to all dangerous drug stocks, prescription records, records of administration, dispensing & compounding equipment, & pharmaceutical/legal library materials);
- Inspects alternative record keeping systems for accountability, security, & positive identification of all parts of practice of pharmacy; &
- Interacts & collaborates with other Pharmacy Board employees in conducting inspections & assisting in investigative matters surrounding licensed & unlicensed facilities possessing dangerous drug stocks.
