



**MINUTES OF THE MONDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2021,  
PROBATION COMMITTEE MEETING**

**9:00 a.m.** The State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy convened in the Hearing Room, 17th Floor, of the Vern Riffe Center for Government and the Arts, 77 South High Street, Columbus, Ohio, for a public meeting, which was also broadcast via Microsoft Teams audio/visual conference call, with the following members present:

**9:00 a.m.** Matthew Pacanovsky made his third appearance before the Probation Committee to remain in compliance with the terms of his Board Order dated December 10, 2018.

**9:08 a.m.** Ms. Dehner and Mr. Koltak led a discussion on Nicole Cogan's request to terminate her probationary period with the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy. A final decision in this matter was tabled for discussion with the full Board at the November Board Meeting, with the Probation Committee's recommendation to approve.

**9:16 a.m.** Ms. Dehner led a discussion on the relapse of a probationer. The Probation Committee determined the probationer's probationary period would be tolled for the duration that her Pharmacist Rehabilitation Contract is on hold in accordance with the tolling guidelines.

**9:21 a.m.** Ms. Dehner led a discussion on the relapse of a probationer. The Probation Committee determined that no tolling was necessary in accordance with the tolling guidelines.

**9:26 a.m.** Ms. Dehner led a discussion on the relapse and surrender request of a probationer. A final decision in this matter was tabled for discussion with the full Board at the November Board Meeting, with the Probation Committee's recommendation to issue a Board Order allowing the probationer to surrender her license but be eligible to apply for Reinstatement or new application of her Pharmacists License if she could demonstrate two years of compliance with the Board's standard terms and conditions.
