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### **Search Warrant Conducted at Springfield Nurse Practitioner's Office and Home**

Springfield, Ohio (Clark County) - On November 21, 2017, State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy Executive Director, Steven W. Schierholt, announced that state and local law enforcement agencies served search warrants at the office and home of nurse practitioner Douglas Shrewsbury.

The State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy began a joint investigation with the Springfield Police Department and Ohio Board of Nursing, after receiving reports that Shrewsbury was allegedly operating a pain management clinic without an appropriate license and issuing prescriptions illegally for controlled substances.

Simultaneous search warrants were conducted at Shrewsbury's office and home, both located in the City of Springfield. Evidence seized included prescription drugs and patient records. No arrests were made during the search warrants. Charges resulting from this investigation will be presented to the Clark County Prosecutor's Office.
