



## Notices of Opportunity for Hearing Mount Carmel Health System

The following Notices of Opportunity for Hearing were issued to licensees of the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy in connection with the investigation of Mount Carmel and William Husel.

The Board's investigation of this matter consisted of a combined 1,562 investigative hours, including conducting 23 interviews and the review of more than 48,000 documents.
