

Use of Contingency Stock License by Institutional Facilities

To promote vaccination storage and administration at long-term care facilities and other institutional facilities, the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy hereby authorizes the following policy:

A long-term care facility or other institutional facility, as defined under agency 4729 of the Ohio Administrative Code, may possess and administer vaccines and other biologics to patients and staff under the terminal distributor of dangerous drugs license issued to the facility's servicing pharmacy (e.g., contingency stock license). This policy shall also permit the use of the servicing pharmacy's contingency stock license to maintain dangerous drugs used to treat adverse reactions to vaccines and biologics stored at the facility.
