Drug Sample Delivery to a Patient's Home During COVID-19

Updated 7/7/2020

The State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy hereby adopts the United States Food and Drug Administration's [Temporary Policy on Prescription Drug Marketing Act Requirements for Distribution of Drug Samples During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency \(June 2020\)](#) authorizing Ohio-licensed drug distributors to deliver drug samples to a patient's home.

This resolution shall remain in effect only for the duration of the Public Health Emergency related to COVID-19 declared by the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) on January 31, 2020, effective January 27, 2020, including any renewals made by the HHS Secretary in accordance with section 319(a)(2) of the Public Health Service Act (PHS Act) (42 U.S.C. 247d(a)(2)).
