



FDA Temporary Policy for Outsourcing Facilities

Updated 5/15/2020

In order to mitigate reported drug shortages, the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy has adopted the following resolution for Ohio-licensed outsourcing facilities.

This guidance is being issued in accordance with a Board resolution adopted on May 4, 2020.

The Board hereby adopts the following FDA policy for Ohio-licensed outsourcing facilities **and any subsequent updates to this policy, including the updated policy issued on May 8, 2020:**
