

## Chemical Capture Classification for Animal Shelters and Dog Wardens Now Available

Section <u>4729.542</u> of the Ohio Revised Code and rule <u>4729:5-15-05</u> of the Ohio Administrative Code allow an animal shelter or county dog warden that holds a limited terminal distributor of dangerous drugs license to apply for a chemical capture classification. This classification permits the holder to purchase, possess, and administer a combination of drugs for chemical capture.
