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Board of Pharmacy Suspends Medina Pharmacy's License Due to Unsafe Compounding Practices

January 18, 2018 – Medina, Ohio – The State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy announced the immediate suspension of the pharmacy license of Clinical Apothecaries, Inc. (4087 Medina Road, Medina, Ohio) for engaging in compounding practices that pose immediate and serious harm to the public.

Due to the serious nature of the infractions, the Board strongly recommends patients immediately discontinue the use of all medications dispensed from Clinical Apothecaries. To confirm the source of the drug, please refer to the medication's labeling. Patients should contact their physician, healthcare provider or veterinarian to obtain new prescriptions. The Board is also reviewing records to contact potentially affected patients directly.

Patients emailing the Board should include their full name, telephone number, the name of the medication and a description of the adverse reaction.
